



Disability Accommodations

Who: Any court patron needing assistance or an accommodation in the courthouse due to a disability.

What: An accommodation request tells the court what you need so you can fully participate.

When: You can request an accommodation at any time.

Where: A request can be made to any judge or court staff member. Every courthouse has one designated person you can talk to, the Court Disability Coordinator.

How: You can request accommodations **orally** by telling a judge or court staff, or **in writing** by filling out a form. You do not need to provide your medical information.

Examples: Admitting a service animal, permitting power-driven mobility devices, allowing a purse to carry necessary supplies, permitting a support person or note-taker to attend court with you, relocating hearings to avoid stairs or be closer to bathrooms, and/or appearing to court remotely.
