- B. The Illinois Open Meeting Act provides that "Any person shall be permitted an opportunity to address public officials under the rules established and recorded by the public body".


IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED as follows by the Morgan County Board of Commissioners:


- 1. Any person who wishes to address the Morgan County Board must refrain from the use of obscene, vulgar, or profane language. They must keep his or her comments limited to three (3) to five (5) minute and related to a topic that is specifically listed on the published agenda for the meeting.
- 2. The Board Chairman, or a majority of the members of the Morgan County Board present at any meeting, shall have discretion to waive the requirements of this resolution and allow members of the public to address the Board without complying with the requirements of this resolution.
- 3. This Resolution shall be effective immediately.
