Morgan County announces Award for the Home Repair and Accessibility Program

JACKSONVILLE, ILLINOIS - Morgan County has been awarded new funding through the Home Repair and Accessibility Program (HRAP), administered by the Illinois Housing Development Authority (IHDA). This funding will soon allow eligible Morgan County households to apply for assistance with critical home repairs and accessibility improvements.

The HRAP program is designed to support low- and very low-income homeowners by providing resources for essential health and safety repairs as well as accessibility modifications. Through these efforts, the program helps preserve existing affordable housing, invests in underserved communities, improves the health and well-being of residents, and enables low-income, disabled, or mobility-impaired individuals to remain safely in their homes.

Due to limited funding, not all eligible households will receive assistance.
